The EX-Ls was founded in 1982 as an organization designed to provide retired and other former employees of Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory a venue to enjoy and benefit from continued association with each other and with the Lab.

The EX-Ls hold quarterly luncheons currently alternating between the Berkeley Yacht Club and H's Lordships, featuring speakers who give updates on research at the Lab or on topics of general interest. Recent speakers, for example, have talked about the Early Earthquake Warning System, the Caldecott Tunnel construction project, the future of electric cars and battery research, as well as periodic reports from the current Directorate on the status of the Laboratory. The EX-Ls also serves as a link to the Laboratory to inform retirees of upcoming events and to facilitate participation in activities such as the periodic Open House, the Lab's booth at the Solano Stroll, and others. The EX-Ls is closely associated with the UC Berkeley Retirement Center (UCBRC) that serves the wider UC Berkeley retirement community - including all LBNL retirees. In addition to serving as a link between retirees and the university, UCBRC provides a variety of services, programs, and classes. For more information go to retirement.berkeley.edu.
